-What is English Second Language?

A basic introduction to the English language. Primary emphasis for all grades are on developing skills in oral communication. In addition, students in grades 3 to 6 are introduced to reading and writing in English as a second language of instruction.

-What if my child's mother tongue is French? What if my child's mother tongue is English?

The course is designed to teach English as a second language of instruction. Therefore, students whose first language is French are not at a disadvantage to students who are fluent in English. Students of both

linguistic backgrounds enjoy the lessons and project themes. There's something for everyone!

- What can I do to help my child in English class, long term and homework?

Don't! Children learn best when they naturally internalize vocabulary and structure through needs and wants.

I would encourage reading English books, listening to English music, joining extracurricular activities where English is spoken, playing games in English, watching English television and movies. By forcing a child to use English (with the best intentions), learning English becomes another chore that they would rather not do; it takes the joy out of learning. Through natural immersion, the child will find a need and a desire to learn.

- What course material is used in English class?

Grades 1 and 2 use the textbook "Little Rascals". Songs and stories are the springboard for language learning. Competencies in reading and writing is not evaluated.

Grades 3 to 6 use the textbook "Chatterbox" on an occasional basis. Themes are followed and courses are adapted.

Grades 4 to 6 use the workbook, "Yes, We Can" over three years to supplement their knowledge of English grammar.
